

PUBLIC NOTICE
DALLASTOWN BOROUGH ACT 537 PLAN AMENDMENT ADOPTION

Notice is hereby given that the Dallastown Borough Council, York County, Pennsylvania proposes to adopt a Sewage Facilities Plan Amendment pursuant to Act 537 following a thirty (30) day public comment period beginning February 13, 2025 and ending March 15, 2025. The Planning Area for this Plan Amendment is the Colonial Park Area of the Borough.

The purpose of the Amendment is to address a change to the proposed Colonial Park Sanitary Sewer Extension Project. The Plan approved by the Department of Environmental Protection on September 17, 2015, called for the construction of a gravity collection system serving the Colonial Park area and a new Pump Station located on the Deller Farm with a proposed force main discharge to Grand Street. The change associated with this notice is to notify the Public that the means of sanitary sewer collection for the Colonial Park area will be revised to include the construction of a low-pressure sewer extension with laterals from each residence connecting to the low-pressure sewer system. Each residence will be required to have a grinder pump for this system. The Borough will procure the grinder pumps required for this system which will be provided to property owners for installation. Each property owner will be responsible for the installation and maintenance of the grinder pump serving their property. This proposed change results in significant cost savings to residents in the project area from the previously proposed gravity collection system and pump station construction.

The Plan Amendment is anticipated to be adopted by the Council during their regularly scheduled Council meeting at the Borough Municipal Building on March 24, 2025 pending receipt of comments.
